







URBAN ART Festival 2020 on 18./19. July 2020

URBAN ART Amstetten invites artists, amateurs and visitors to let Amstetten's center shine as urban space through street painting, graffiti and street art.

Over the period of May and June, colorful projects by schools and institutions begin to grow in our streets. Everything ends in a festival on 18/19. July. Through live performances by international and national artists as well as hobby artists (adults, teenagers and children) the streets around the main square of Amstetten, accompanied by music and film, will tell colorful stories. This marks the start of a festival series in the coming years.

The aim is ...

to carry art (as a political, social and aesthetic signal) into our streets,

to tell personal and collective stories in public,

react to our environment (floor / street / walls / objects),

To make art visible in public space,

to invite to art and

to perceive our streets as an urban space.

Participation is possible in different categories and disciplines.

Disciplines

2D and 3D street paintings on the main square and in the side streets.

Graffiti and wall painting around the main square, railway underpasses, on walls and plans.

Street art objects and variants throughout the festival area.

International and national artists.

Hobby artists (categories: adults, young people, kids I and II, families / mixed, companies / organizations)

The participants receive a **starter package** including basic materials, a meal voucher, a beverage voucher and a voucher for the catalog.
